After School Program: Monday– Friday 2:15-5:00pm

- * Have fun working with children, helping with homework and taking part in exciting activities like arts and crafts, games, cooking, computers and much more!

Kid's Cafe: Monday– Friday 4:30-6:00pm

- * Help set up, serve and clean up a hot dinner for neighborhood children.

Hot Lunch Program: Monday- Saturday 9:00am-1:30pm

- * Help prepare, serve and clean up lunch for 80-150 people.

Clothing House: Tuesday- Thursday 9:30am-12:30pm

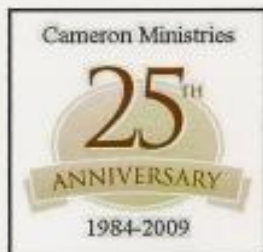
- * Sort clothes, organize the store and help customers shop.

- * Help provide a fun, safe place for children during the summer- field trips, swimming, crafts, sports and a special reading program.
